Individuals with a wide range of challenges and needs are supported throughout Sussex County in SCARC group homes and supervised apartments. Direct Support Professionals trained in providing residential supports staff each of our homes. An Individual Support Plan which outlines goals and objectives designed to promote and enhance quality of life is developed for all residents. Individuals who choose a SCARC residence participate in the care of their home and the day to day activities which contribute to creating a sense of warmth and stability within the home.



SCARC group homes vary in size, occupancy, and location. Every effort is made to serve individuals from Sussex County or those who have families in Sussex County, although some of our residents originally lived in other counties. In addition to group homes, SCARC Individualized Living Programs support residents with unique needs in having successful community-based lives.



Most individuals living in SCARC residences are eligible for Supplemental Security Income from the Social Security Administration and for individual budgets from the NJ Division of Developmental Disabilities.

All of our group homes and apartments are licensed by the New Jersey Department of Human Resources on an annual basis. All programs are inspected and evaluated each year by the SCARC Board of Trustee's Safety Committee.

SCARC partners with all federal, state, and county affordable housing programs, and many of our residents receive rental assistance. SCARC is an equal housing opportunity organization.
