The Eickmann Center offers individuals community-based activities as well as the opportunity to build workplace skills. In order to fulfill piece rate contracts for local companies such as Thorlabs in Newton, individuals



become involved in every step of production from the acquisition of materials to the delivery of final products.

Individuals receive compensation based on the current minimum wage.

The Eickmann Center offers opportunities to acquire skills necessary for competitive employment as well as opportunities for socialization and community interaction.

Participants enjoy exploring their community during lunches at nearby restaurants, shopping trips, and visits to local parks. As part of their day at The Eickmann Center



individuals also receive instruction in nutrition and self-advocacy, and participate in lively discussions on current events.

Located at 4 Camre Drive in Newton, New Jersey, the Eickmann Center is open Monday through Friday from 9 am to 2 pm. The Center is staffed by Day Habilitation Direct Support Professionals (DSPs), at a ratio of one DSP to approximately 6 individuals. Transportation is available for attendees within the Center's transportation catchment area.



General Information

The Eickmann Center is one of SCARC's six day programs and has been in operation since 2010 providing day habilitation and prevocational training services.

SCARC's day programs are licensed and funded by the New Jersey Department of Human Services and the New Jersey Division of Developmental Disabilities.
