## The Senior Center

Located in Sparta, the Senior Center provides supports to individuals who wish to “retire” from employment or more intensive day activities.

The Senior Center offers individuals with developmental disabilities companionship, and meaningful leisure activities such as crafts, cooking, and shopping.



Individuals who wish to pursue particular hobbies or interests are supported in their goals.

Also, in order to keep our seniors with disabilities as active as possible, community outings, adaptive recreation, and social gatherings are an integral part of each week.

Persons with developmental disabilities often grow older at faster rates and in more prominent ways than the non-disabled population. SCARC offers a program especially tailored to those individuals looking for a slower paced program that still offers them enriching days and interesting activities in the company of their peers.



Located at 26 Gail Court, Sparta, New Jersey, the Senior Center is open Monday through Friday from 9 am to 2 pm. The Center is staffed by Day Habilitation Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) at a ratio of one DSP to 3 individuals. Transportation is available for attendees within the Center’s transportation catchment area.



### General Information

The Senior Center is one of SCARC’s six day programs offering day habilitation services. It has been in operation since 1998.

SCARC’s day programs are licensed and funded by the New Jersey Department of Human Services and the New Jersey Division of Developmental Disabilities.
