The Sparta Center

The Sparta Center is the only program of its kind in Sussex County providing services to individuals with significant physical and intellectual support needs or who may be considered medically fragile. Nursing staff are available to monitor conditions such as diabet-



tes, cardiac, respiratory, and renal/kidney issues. They can also provide oxygen administration, inhalation therapy, tracheotomy care, suctioning, wound care and gastrostomy feedings.

At the Sparta Center quality of life is an important facet of meeting care needs. Meaningful, person-centered daily routines focusing on social interaction, leisure activities, and learning are developed for each individual. Programs on music,



nature, and art are frequently shared by local organizations and individuals providing the opportunity to interact with community members. Trips into the community are carefully arranged with recognition of the particular interests and limitations of the participants.

Located at 26 Gail Court, Sparta, New Jersey, the Sparta Center is open Monday through Friday from 9 am to 2 pm. The Center is staffed by Day Habilitation Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) at a ratio of one DSP to 3 individuals. Transportation is available for attendees within the Center's transportation catchment area.



General Information

The Sparta Center is one of SCARC's six day programs offering day habilitation and pre-vocational training services. It has been in operation since 2008.

SCARC's day programs are licensed and funded by the New Jersey Department of Human Services and the New Jersey Division of Developmental Disabilities.
