Our History

In 1957, a group of Sussex County parents, unable to find services to meet the needs of their children with developmental disabilities, formed SCARC, Inc. In order to serve these children, a preschool program, recreation programs, and a day training program were developed.



Over the next few years, the demand for a wider range of services grew and SCARC expanded to include a day program (1969), an elementary school program (1972), and their first two group homes (1980).

Today, SCARC operates 22 group homes, 6 community apartments, 6 day programs, and provides supported employment, prevocational training, career planning, community inclusion, and family support services.



In addition, SCARC has two sister corporations. SCARC Guardianship Services, Inc provides guardianship and community trust services. The SCARC Foundation, Inc raises funds for SCARC, Inc. and SCARC Guardianship Services, Inc programs.



Enabling individuals to live lives of dignity and value is of primary importance in the design of SCARC services. Our over sixty years of experience, combined with an understanding of the flexibility and sensitivity required to address diverse needs and abilities, enables SCARC to provide quality supports for the over 500 individuals that it is honored to serve.
