

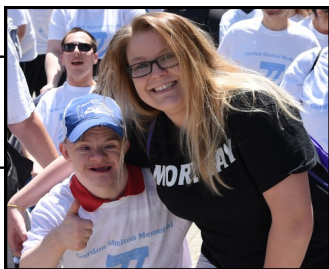


The SCARC Foundation is a non-profit corporation founded in 1985 to support the missions of SCARC, Inc. and SCARC Guardianship Services, Inc.
